Request for Expression of Interest for Assessment of Groundwater potential zonation in Terai belts of Parsa, Bara, Rautahat, Sarlahi and Mohottari Districts

1. Government of Nepal (GoN) has allocated fund toward the cost of **Assessment of Groundwater potential zonation in Terai belts of Parsa, Bara, Rautahat, Sarlahi and Mohottari Districts** and intends to apply a portion of this fund to eligible payments under the Contract for which this EOI is invited for National consulting services.
2. The Water Resources Research and Development Centre now invites EOI for eligible consulting firms (“consultant”) to provide the following consulting services: **Assessment of Groundwater potential zonation in Terai belts of Parsa, Bara, Rautahat, Sarlahi and Mohottari Districts**. *The main objective of this study is to delineate groundwater potential zones (Shallow and deep) and prepare groundwater potential map.*
3. Interested eligible consultants may obtain further information at the address Water Resources Research and Development Centre, Pulchowk, Lalitpur during office hours on or before **24th November, 2024, or visit e-GP system** www.bolpatra.gov.np or visit the client’s website www.wrrdc.gov.np.
4. Consultants may associate with other consultants to enhance their qualifications.
5. EOI shall be delivered online through e-GP system www.bolpatra.gov.np on or before **24th November, 2024, 12:00 hours. EOI received after deadline will be rejected.** EOI shall be opened on **13:00 hours on 24th November, 2024,** at the office of WRRDC, Pulchowk, Lalitpur
6. In case of the last date of obtaining and submission of the EOI documents happens to be a holiday, the next working day will be deemed as the due date but the time will be the same as stipulated.
7. EOI will be assessed based on Qualification **40%**, Experience **50%**, and capacity **10%** of consulting firms and key personnel. Based on evaluation of EOI, only shortlisted firms will be invited to submit technical and financial proposal through a request for proposal.
8. Minimum score to pass the EOI is **60**.
